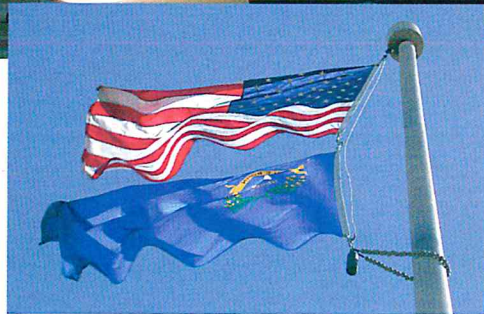

While students would rather avoid run-ins with Gerry, most are aware of the important role he plays at Greenspun.

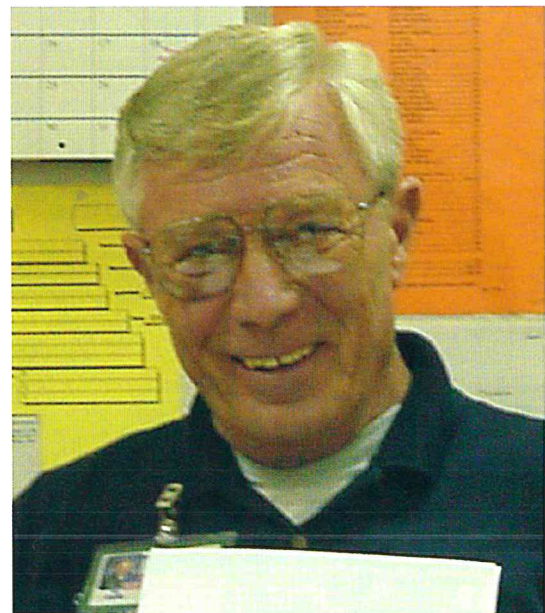

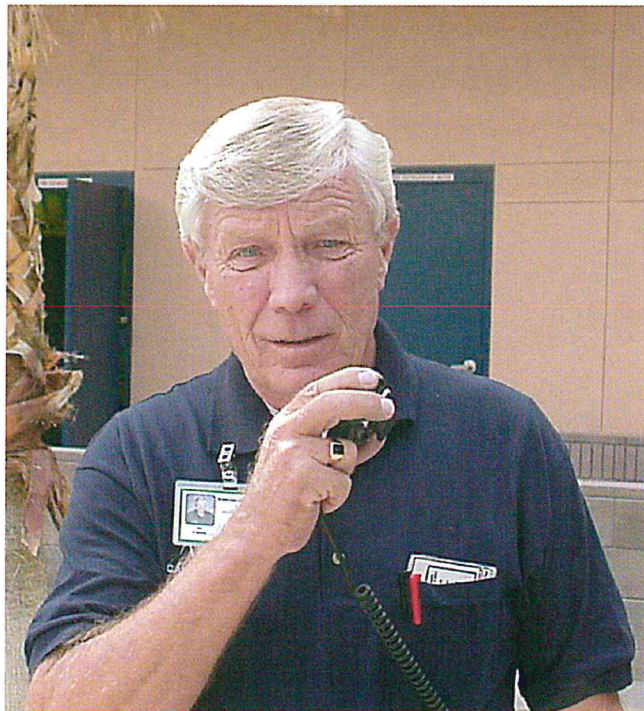
So whether or not you had an incident with Gerry this year, you can rest assured that the school will remain safe as long as he's here.

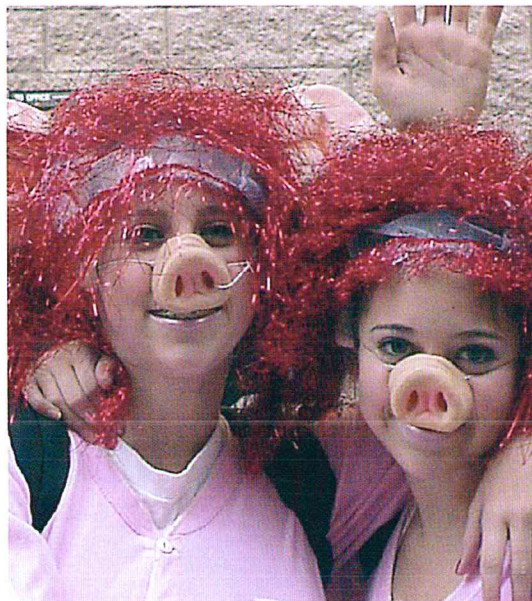

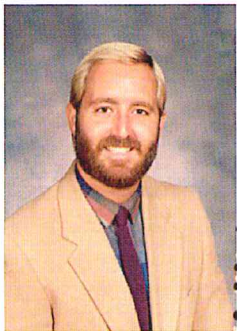

Twelve years older and stronger, the teachers at Greenspun say that the No. 1 reason they remained on this campus is because it's a great school with outstanding kids.

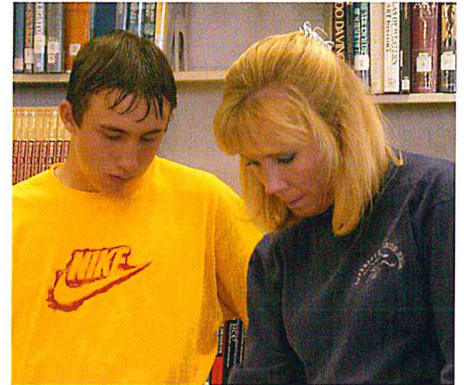

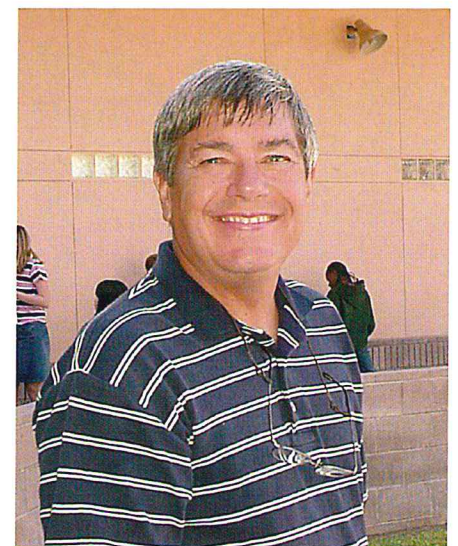
Hopefully, when you come back in another dozen years, you will still find some well aged teachers that will be remembered forever in an ancient school called Greenspun Junior High.

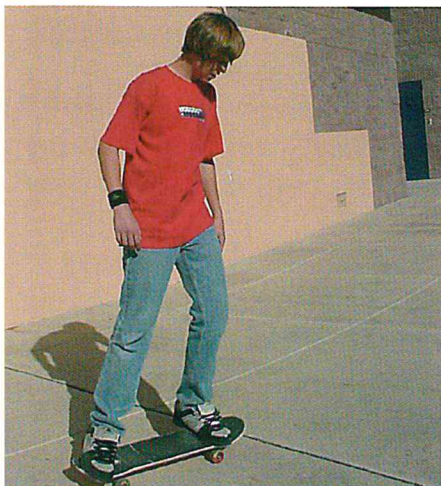
Extreme Style

After six hours of learning at school, these kids go home and finish their homework. Then they hop on their bikes, pick up their skateboards, or run their fingers over a set of guitar strings.

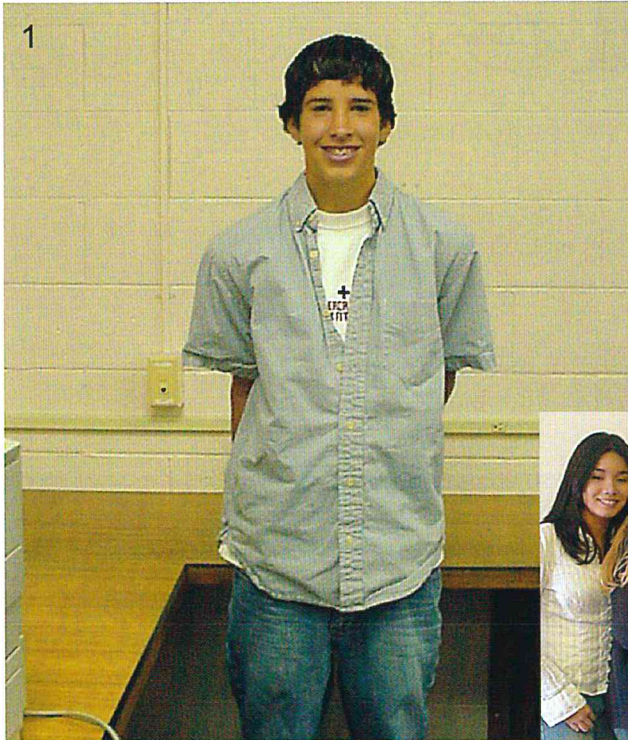

EXTREMES

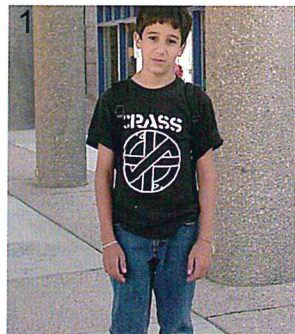

Mrs. Badal, the Student Council supervisor, said she didn't know what she'd do without Laura's help.

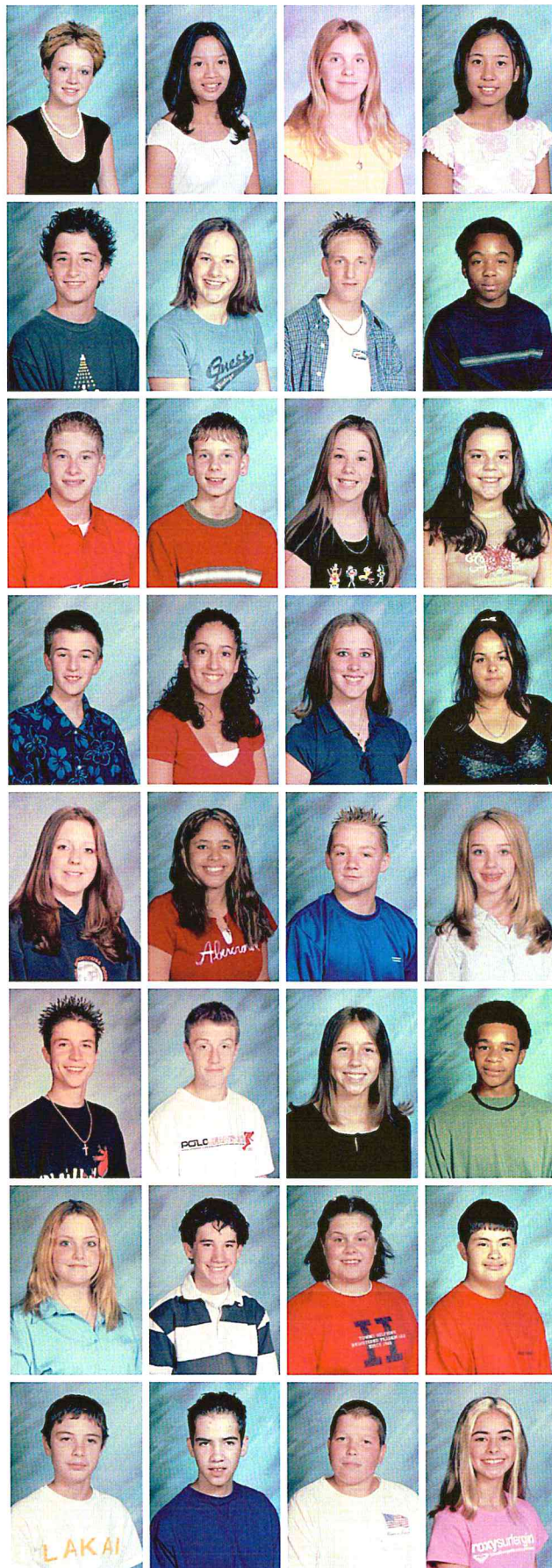

Laura can't wait for her future, but right now her future has just begun.

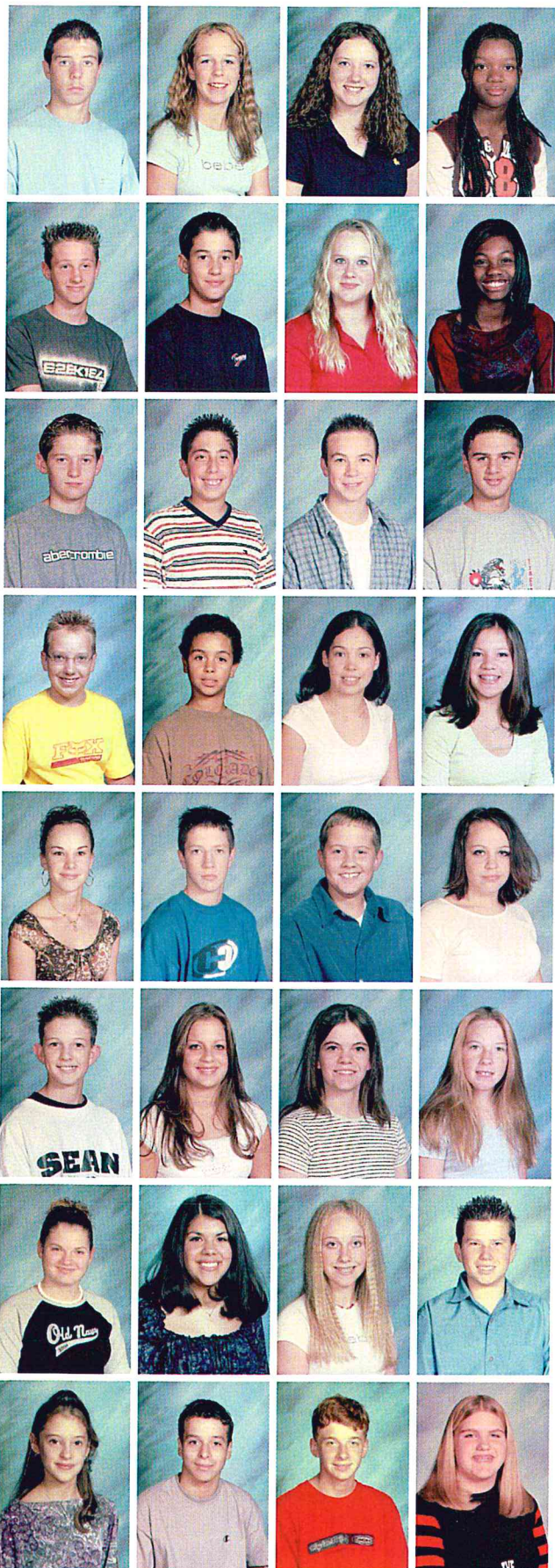

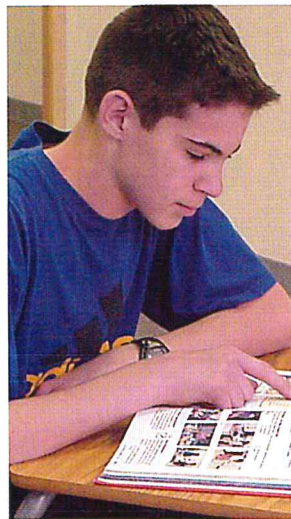
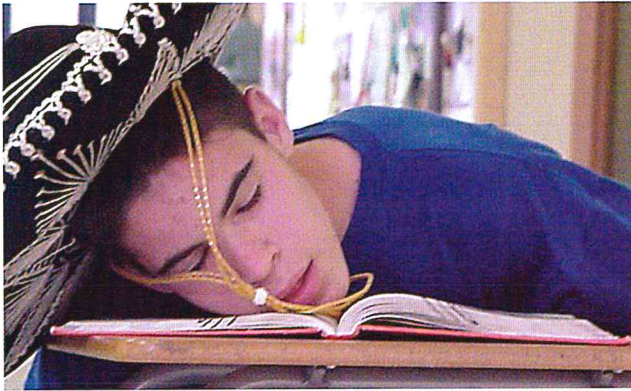
No matter what Anthony chooses to do when he grows up, his work will surely be music to the ears.

Leading by Example

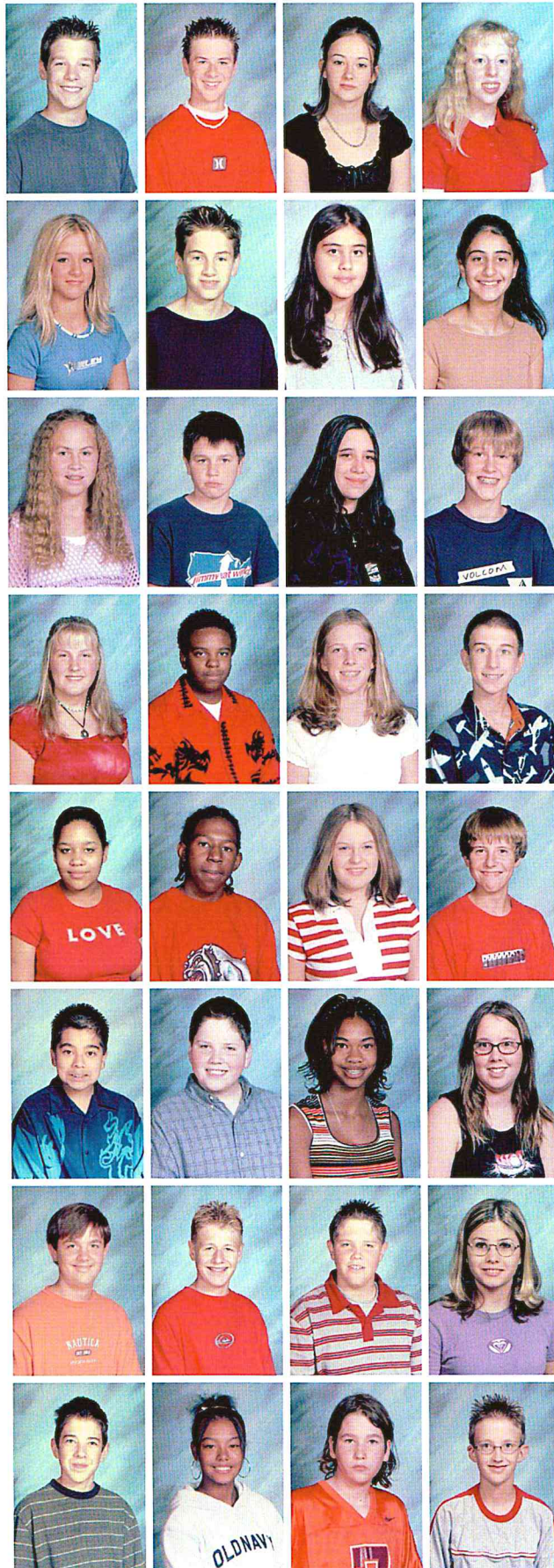
"David is a Renaissance man. He knows a little bit of everything," Spanish teacher Mrs. Molinaro said. "He's interesting to talk to."

So if you see this basketball-playing, straight-A achieving swimmer in high school, say "hi." You just might make a valuable new friend.

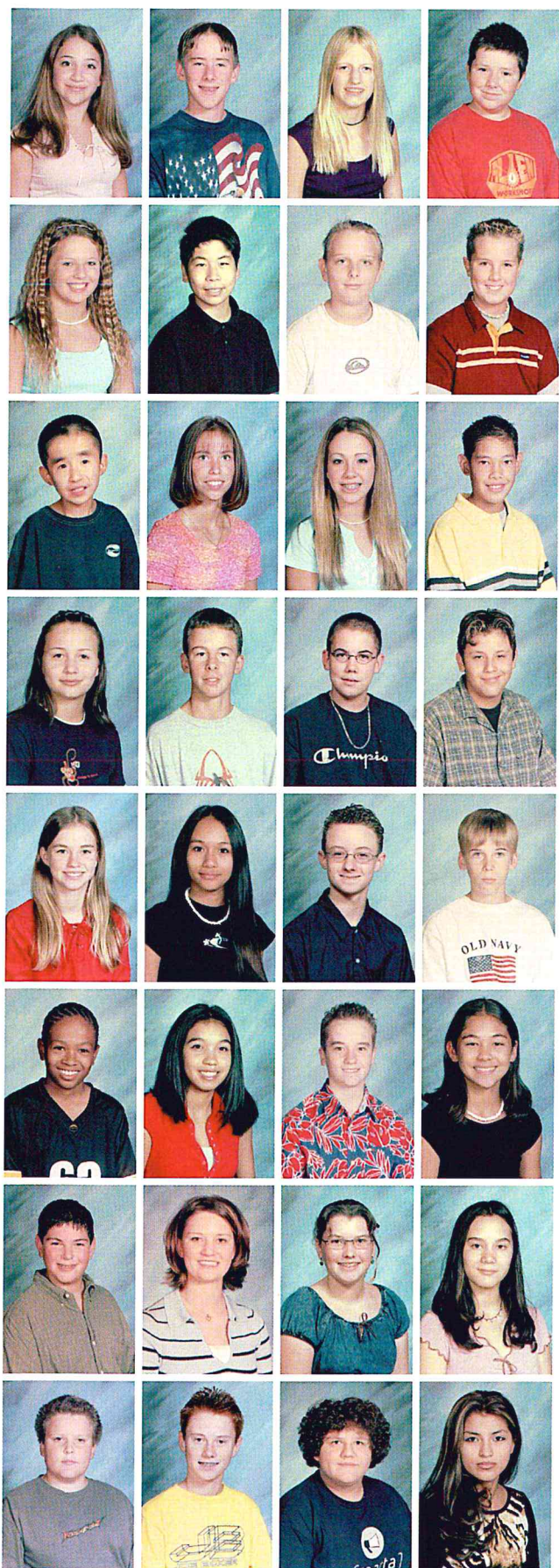

Mrs. Badal, supervisor of the Student Council, said Natalie was an ideal vice-president.

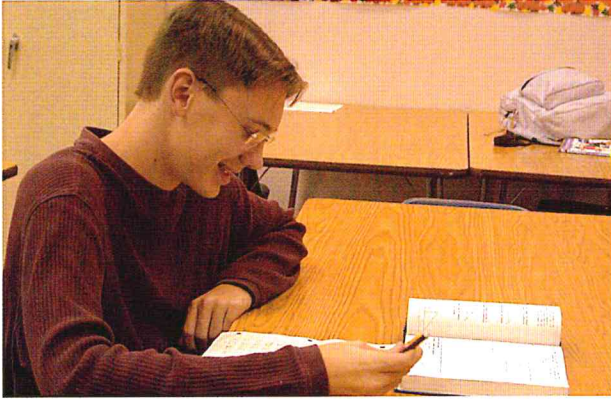
"Natalie has many qualities needed to succeed in the future," Mrs. Badal said. "She is very organized and responsible, which is really important."

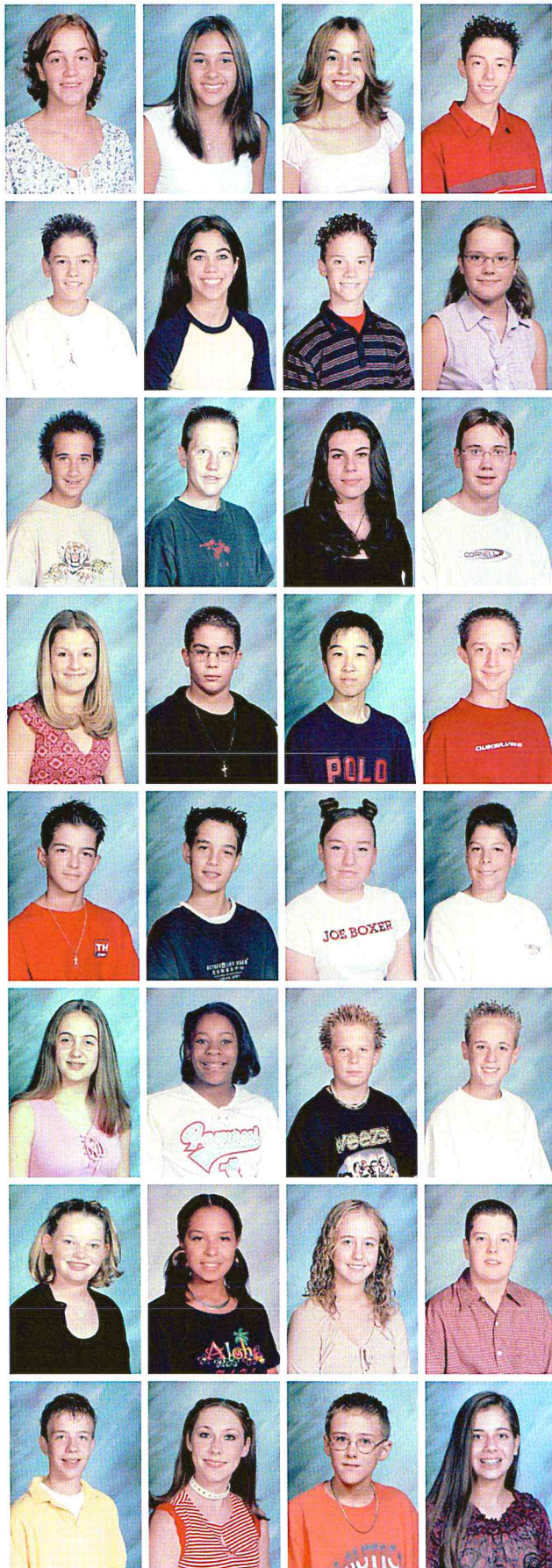

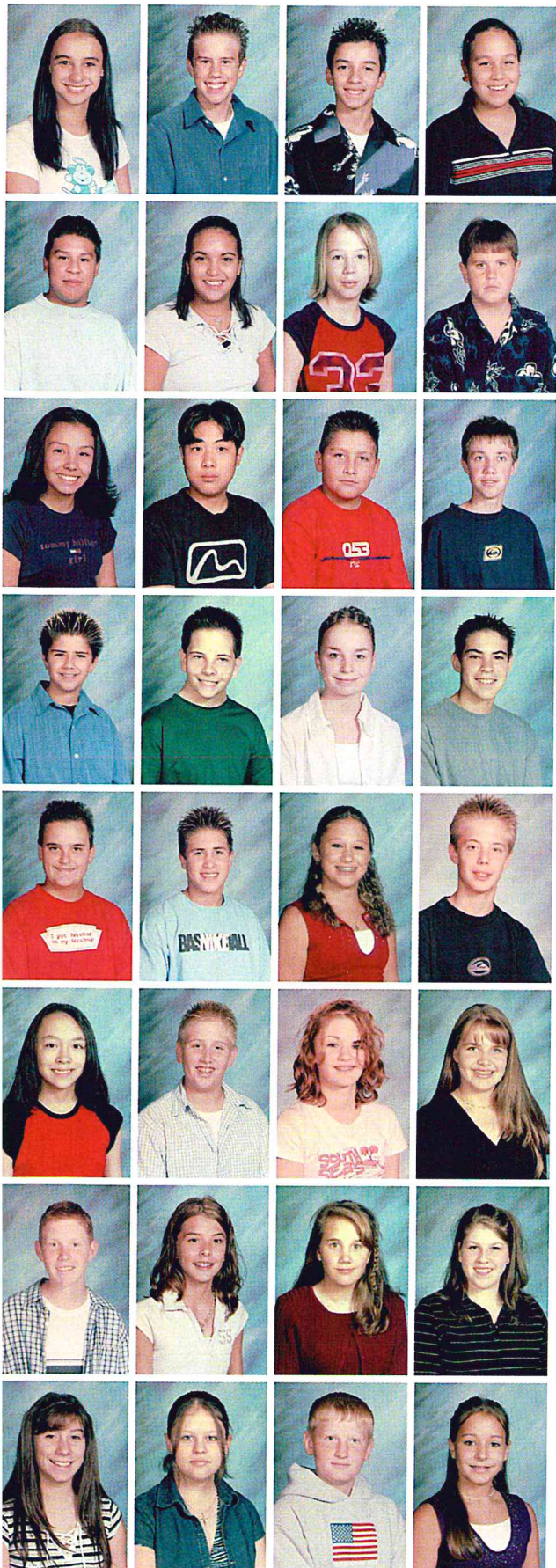

By the start of the seventh grade, Sammy decided that studies would have to come first if he wanted to be a pilot.

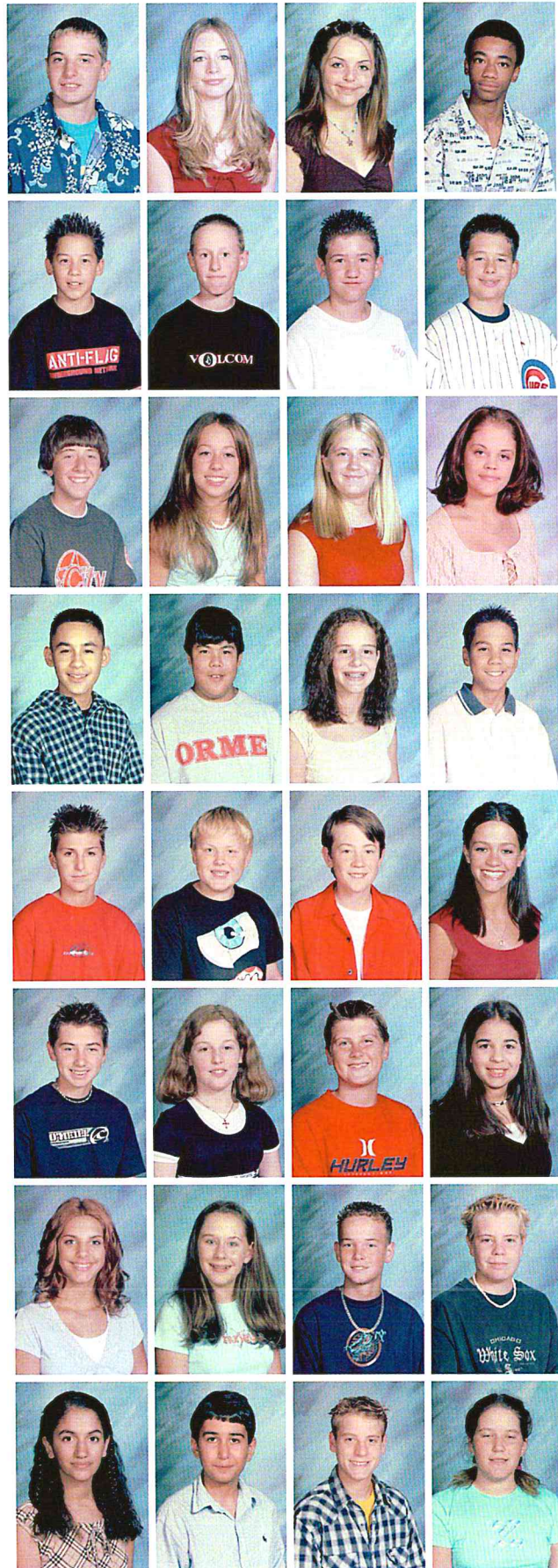
That's when he changed his attitude.

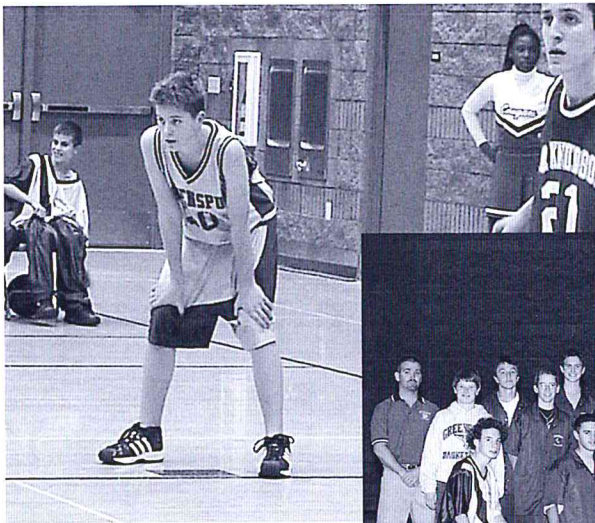
Despite the lack of height on the boy's basketball lineup, the team had plenty of wins this season.
